Mr. CRAIG introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Benjamin M. Banfro.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.**

4 In the administration of the Immigration and Nation-
5 ality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101 et seq.), Benjamin M. Banfro
6 shall be held and considered to have been lawfully admit-
7 ted to the United States for permanent residence as of
8 the date of the enactment of this Act upon payment of
9 the required visa fees.

10 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.**

11 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Ben-
12 jamin M. Banfro as provided in this Act, the Secretary

1 of State shall instruct the proper officer to reduce by one
2 number during the current fiscal year the total number
3 of immigrant visas available to natives of the country of
4 the alien's birth under subsection (a) of section 203 of
5 the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1153).
