# A BILL

To provide for the retroactive entitlement of Ed W. Freeman to Medal of Honor special pension.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. RETROACTIVE MEDAL OF HONOR SPECIAL**  
4       **PENSION FOR ED W. FREEMAN.**

5       (a) ENTITLEMENT.—(1) Notwithstanding any other  
6       provision of law, Ed W. Freeman of Boise, Idaho, shall  
7       be entitled to the special pension provided for under sec-  
8       tion 1562 of title 38, United States Code (and antecedent  
9       provisions of law), for months beginning with November  
10      1965 and ending with June 2001.

1       (2) The entitlement of Ed W. Freeman to special  
2 pension under paragraph (1) is in addition to the entitlement  
3 of Ed W. Freeman to special pension for months  
4 after June 2001 under law.

5       (b) AMOUNT.—The amount of special pension payable  
6 under subsection (a) for a month beginning before  
7 the date of the enactment of this Act shall be the amount  
8 of special pension provided for by law for that month for  
9 persons entered and recorded in the Army, Navy, Air  
10 Force, and Coast Guard Medal of Honor Roll (or antecedent  
11 Medal of Honor Roll required by law).
