- 3 SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF DUTY ON ARTICHOKES THAT
- 4 ARE PREPARED OR PRESERVED WITH VIN-
- 5 EGAR OR ACETIC ACID.
- 6 (a) In General.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
- 7 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
- 8 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
- 9 new heading:

						12/31/2004	".

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 2 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn
- 3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day
- 4 after the date of enactment of this Act.
