	"9902.42.02 Bags (provided for in subheading 4202.92.45) intended for transporting, storing, or proteeting dolls, toys, and other articles provided for in headings 9502 through 9504, inclusive, imported, and sold with such articles therein Free No change No change On or before 12/31/2005 ".
