- 3 SECTION 1. ESTABLISHMENT OF ELECTION DAY IN PRESI-
- 4 DENTIAL ELECTION YEARS AS A LEGAL PUB-
- 5 LIC HOLIDAY.
- 6 Section 6103(a) of title 5, United States Code, is
- 7 amended by inserting after the matter relating to Colum-
- 8 bus Day, the following undesignated paragraph:

- 1 "Presidential Election Day, the Tuesday next after
- 2 the first Monday in November, in 2004 and each fourth

3 year thereafter.".
