## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on saccharose used for nonfood, nonnutritional purposes, as a seed kernel and in additional layers in an industrial granulation process for biocatalyst production.

3       **SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF DUTY ON SACCHAROSE.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of

5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is

6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following

7 new heading:

"	9902.17.01	Saccharose used for nonfood, non-nutritional purposes, as a seed kernel and in additional layers in an industrial granulation process for biocatalyst production (provided for in subheading 1701.99) .....

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—

16 (B) with respect to which there would have  
17 been no duty, if the amendment made by sub-  
18 section (a) applied to such entry or withdrawal,

1 shall be liquidated or reliquidated as though such  
2 entry or withdrawal occurred on the 15th day after  
3 the date of enactment of this Act.
