## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on saccharose used for nonfood, nonnutritional purposes, as a seed kernel and in additional layers in an industrial granulation process for biocatalyst production.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF DUTY ON SACCHAROSE.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5       the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6       amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
7       new heading:

“	9902.17.01	Saccharose used for nonfood, non-nutritional purposes, as a seed kernel and in additional layers in an industrial granulation process for biocatalyst production (provided for in subheading 1701.99) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2004	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—

2 (1) IN GENERAL.—The amendment made by  
3 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or with-  
4 drawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after  
5 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.

6 (2) RELIQUIDATION.—Notwithstanding section  
7 514 of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1514) or  
8 any other provision of law, upon a request filed with  
9 the United States Customs Service on or before the  
10 90th day after the date of enactment of this Act,  
11 any entry, or withdrawal from warehouse for con-  
12 sumption, of an article—

13 (A) that was made after December 31,  
14 2000, and before the 15th day after the date of  
15 enactment of this Act, and

16 (B) with respect to which there would have  
17 been no duty, if the amendment made by sub-  
18 section (a) applied to such entry or withdrawal,

1        shall be liquidated or reliquidated as though such  
2        entry or withdrawal occurred on the 15th day after  
3        the date of enactment of this Act.
