5	(a) In General.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6	the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7	amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8	new heading:
	" 9902.59.00 Nonwoven filter cloth, comprising a nonwoven web of electrostatically-charged split-film polypropylene fibers weighing 20–70 grams per square meter, inclusive, needle-tacked to an open polyethylene scrim support having no more than 12 threads per cm (provided for in HTS subheading 5911.40.00)

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
- 3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after

4 the date that is 15 days after the date of enactment of

5 this Act.
