A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain filter media.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF DUTY ON CERTAIN FILTER**
4 **MEDIA.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new heading:

“	9902.59.00	Nonwoven filter cloth, comprising a nonwoven web of electrostatically-charged split-film polypropylene fibers weighing 20–70 grams per square meter, inclusive, needle-tacked to an open polyethylene scrim support having no more than 12 threads per cm (provided for in HTS subheading 5911.40.00).	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2005	”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after
4 the date that is 15 days after the date of enactment of
5 this Act.
