A BILL

To reduce temporarily the duty on N-Cyclohexylthiophthalimide.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. N-CYCLOHEXYLTHIOPHTHALIMIDE.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
7 new heading:

“	9902.29.82	N-Cyclohexylthiophthalimide (CAS No. 17796–82–6) (provided for in sub-heading 2930.90.24)	3%	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2005	”.

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
9 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn

- 1 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day
- 2 after the date of enactment of this Act.
