5	(a) In General.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6	the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7	amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8	new subheading:
	" 9902.33.41 Triethyleneglycol-bis-(3-tert-butyl-4-hydroxy-5-methylphenyl) propionate (CAS No. 36443-68-2 (provided for in subheading 2918.90.43)

- 1 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 2 subsection (a) applies with respect to goods entered, or
- 3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after

4 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.
