5	(a) In General.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of

8	new heading:
	"9902.85.22 Electrical devices designed to receive and monitor publicly transmitted radio communications, valued at over \$40 each, that are intended to be hand-held (provided for in subheading 8527.19.50) Free No change No change On or before 12/31/2005 ".

- 3 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day

4 after the date of enactment of this Act.
