3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF RICHARD S. ARNOLD UNITED**
4 **STATES COURTHOUSE.**

5 The United States courthouse located at 600 West
6 Capitol Avenue in Little Rock, Arkansas, and any addition
7 to the courthouse that may hereafter be constructed, shall
8 be known and designated as the “Richard S. Arnold
9 United States Courthouse”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the United
4 States courthouse referred to in section 1 shall be deemed
5 to be a reference to the Richard S. Arnold United States
6 Courthouse.
