## A BILL

To provide for the reliquidation of certain entries of antifriction bearings.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. RELIQUIDATION OF CERTAIN ENTRIES OF
- 4 ANTIFRICTION BEARINGS.
- 5 (a) In General.—Notwithstanding section 514 of
- 6 the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1514) or any other pro-
- 7 vision of law, the United States Customs Service shall, not
- 8 later than 180 days after the date of enactment of this
- 9 Act, liquidate or reliquidate the entries described in sub-
- 10 section (b) and any amounts owed by the United States
- 11 pursuant to the liquidation or reliquidation shall be re-

- 1 funded with interest, subject to the decision of the United
- 2 States Court of International Trade and the provisions of
- 3 the Amended Final Results of Antidumping Duty Admin-
- 4 istrative Reviews (62 Fed. Reg. 32755; dated June 17,
- 5 1997).
