## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on chloroacetic acid.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CHLOROACETIC ACID.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
7 new heading:

“	9902.39.34	Chloroacetic acid (CAS No. 79–11–8) (provided for in subheading 2915.40.10)	Free	Free	No change	On or before 12/31/2006	”.

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
9 subsection (a) applies to articles entered, or withdrawn

- 1 from warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day
- 2 after the date of enactment of this Act.
