A BILL

To provide for the duty-free entry of certain tramway cars for use by the city of Portland, Oregon.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. CERTAIN TRAMWAY CARS.
- 4 The Secretary of the Treasury shall admit free of
- 5 duty 2 tramway cars (provided for in subheading
- 6 8603.10.00 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the
- 7 United States) manufactured in Plzen, Czech Republic,
- 8 for the use of the city of Portland, Oregon. If the liquida-
- 9 tion of the entry of one or both tramway cars becomes
- 10 final before the date of enactment of this Act, the Sec-

- 1 retary of the Treasury, notwithstanding any other provi-
- 2 sion of law, shall—
- 3 (1) within 15 days after such date, reliquidate
- 4 the entry in accordance with the provisions of this
- 5 Act; and
- 6 (2) at the time of such reliquidation, make the
- 7 appropriate refund of any duty paid with respect to

8 the entry.
