- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. REPEAL OF ANTIDUMPING ACT OF 1916.
- 4 Title VIII of the Act entitled "An Act to increase the
- 5 revenue, and for other purposes", approved September 8,
- 6 1916 (15 U.S.C. 71 et seq.), is repealed.
- 7 SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.
- 8 The repeal under section 1 shall take effect on the
- 9 date of the enactment of this Act and shall apply to any
- 10 case pending on such date.
