A BILL

To repeal the Antidumping Act of 1916.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF ANTIDUMPING ACT OF 1916.**

4 Title VIII of the Act entitled “An Act to increase the
5 revenue, and for other purposes”, approved September 8,
6 1916 (15 U.S.C. 71 et seq.), is repealed.

7 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

8 The repeal under section 1 shall take effect on the
9 date of the enactment of this Act and shall apply to any
10 case pending on such date.
