## A BILL

To clarify certain provisions of the Tariff Suspension and Trade Act of 2000.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*  
3   **SECTION 1. CLARIFICATION OF CERTAIN RELIQUIDATION  
4 PROVISIONS.**

5       The term “any amounts owed” in sections 1404(c),  
6 1405(c), 1408(c), 1409(c), 1410(c), and 1411(c) of the  
7 Tariff Suspension and Trade Act of 2000 (Public Law  
8 106–476), means amounts owed by the United States in-  
9 cluding refund of duties and interest accrued from the  
10 date the applicable article is entered, or withdrawn from

1 warehouse for consumption, to the date of the reliquida-  
2 tion of the entries.
