## A BILL

To amend the Federal Deposit Insurance Act with respect to municipal deposits.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Municipal Deposit In-
- 5 surance Protection Act of 2001".
- 6 SEC. 2. FDIC INSURANCE OF MUNICIPAL DEPOSITS.
- 7 Section 11(a)(2) of the Federal Deposit Insurance
- 8 Act (12 U.S.C. 1821(a)(2)) is amended by adding at the
- 9 end the following:
- 10 "(C) Municipal depositors.—

1	"(i) In general.—Notwithstanding subpara-
2	graph (A), the deposits of an in-State municipal de-
3	positor at an insured depository institution shall be
4	insured in an amount equal to the total amount of
5	those deposits.
6	"(ii) Definitions.—In this subparagraph—
7	"(I) the term 'in-State municipal depositor'
8	means a municipal depositor that is located in
9	the same State as the office or branch of the
10	insured depository institution at which the de-
11	posits of that depositor are held; and
12	"(II) the term 'municipal depositor' means
13	a depositor described in any of clauses (i)
