## A BILL

To amend the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States to provide a tariff-rate quota for certified organic sugar.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

- 3 SECTION 1. CREATION OF TARIFF-RATE QUOTA FOR OR-
- 4 GANIC SUGAR IMPORTS.
- 5 (a) Amendment to Additional United States
- 6 Notes.—Additional United States Note 5(a)(1) of chap-
- 7 ter 17 of the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United
- 8 States is amended—
- 9 (1) in the second sentence, by striking "may"
- and inserting "shall"; and

(2) by adding at the end the following: "The quota quantity reserved for the importation of specialty sugars shall include a minimum quantity to be reserved for the importation of certified organic sugar in an amount not less than 12,000 metric tons to be charged against the aggregate quantity for raw cane sugar or against the aggregate quantity for sugars, syrups, and molasses other than raw cane sugar in such proportions as the Secretary shall determine based on information available to the Secretary concerning the polarization of the certified organic sugar imported hereunder.".

13 (b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by 14 this section shall take effect not later than 15 days after 15 the date of enactment of this Act.
