A BILL

To provide for the reliquidation of a certain drawback claim relating to juices.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. RELIQUIDATION OF DRAWBACK CLAIM RELAT-
- 4 ING TO JUICES.
- 5 (a) In General.—Notwithstanding section 514 of
- 6 the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. 1514) or any other pro-
- 7 vision of law, the United States Customs Service shall, not
- 8 later than 90 days after the date of the enactment of this
- 9 Act, reliquidate the entry described in subsection (c) at
- 10 the full amount claimed in such entry.

- 1 (b) Payment of Amounts Owed.—Any amounts
- 2 owed by the United States pursuant to the reliquidation
- 3 under subsection (a) shall be paid by the Customs Service
- 4 within 90 days after such reliquidation.
- 5 (c) AFFECTED ENTRY.—The entry referred to in
- 6 subsection (a) is as follows:
