## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on Sulfur Black 1.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SULFUR BLACK 1.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
7 new heading:

“	9902.33.41	Sulfur Black 1 (CAS No. 1326– 82–5) (provided for in subheading 3204.19.30) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2006	”.

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
9 this section applies with respect to goods entered, or with-

- 1 drawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after the
- 2 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.
