## A BILL

3       **SECTION 1. TRIMETHYL CYCLO HEXANOL (1-METHYL-3,3-**  
4       **DIMETHYLCYCLOHEXANOL-5).**

5       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
6       the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
7       amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
8       new heading:

1           (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
