## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on low expansion laboratory  
glass.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. STOPPERS, LIDS, AND OTHER CLOSURES.**

4       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
5       the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
6       amended by inserting in the numerical sequence the fol-  
7       lowing new heading:

“	9902.70.30	Stoppers, lids, and other clo- sures: Produced by automatic machine (pro- vided for in subheading 7010.20.20) ....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2007	”.

1       (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 this section shall apply with respect to goods entered, or  
3 withdrawn from warehouse for consumption, on or after  
4 the 15th day after the date of enactment of this Act.
