A BILL

To amend the National Sea Grant College Program Act.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "National Sea Grant
- 5 College Program Act Amendments of 2002".

7	SEC. 3. REQUIREMENTS APPLICABLE TO NATIONAL SEA

9	(a) Quadrennial Strategic Plan.—Section 204
0	(c)(1) of the National Sea Grant College Program Act (33
1	U.S.C. 1123 (c)(1)) is amended to read as follows: "The
2	Secretary, in consultation with the panel, sea grant col-
3	leges, and sea grant institutes, shall develop at least every
4	4 years a strategic plan which establishes priorities for the
5	national sea grant college program, provides an appro-
6	priately balanced response to local, regional, and national
7	needs, and is reflective of integration with the strategic
8	plans of the Department of Commerce and of NOAA.".
9	(b) Allocation of Funding.—Section
20	204(d)(3)(B) of the National Sea Grant College Program
21	Act (33 U.S.C. 1123(d)(3)(B)) is amended.—
22	(1) by striking "and" after the semicolon at the
23	end of clause (ii);
24	(2) by adding at the end the following:

- 4 (c) Ensuring Equal Access.—Section 208(a) of

- 8 taged students to the program carried out under this sub-
- 9 section.".

10 SEC. 4. TERMS OF MEMBERSHIP FOR SEA GRANT REVIEW

- 11 PANEL.
- Section 209(c)(2) of the National Sea Grant College
- 13 Program Act (33 U.S.C. 1128(c)(2)) is amended by strik-
- 14 ing the first sentence and inserting the following: "The
- 15 term of office of a voting member of the panel shall be
- 16 3 years for a member appointed before the date of enact-
- 17 ment of the National Sea Grant College Program Act
- 18 Amendments of 2002, and 4 years for a member ap-
- 19 pointed or reappointed after the date of enactment of the
- 20 National Sea Grant College Program Act Amendments of
- 21 2002. The Director may extend the term of office of a

14	"(E) $$85,000,000$ for fiscal year 2008.						
15	"(2) Priority Research.—In addition to the						
16	amount authorized under paragraph (1), there are						
17	authorized to be appropriated for each of fiscal years						
18	2004 through 2008—						
19	"(A) \$5,000,000 for competitive grants for						
20	university research on biology and control of						
21	zebra mussels and other important non-native						
22	species as identified in section $1301(b)(4)(A)$ of						
23	the Nonindigenous Aquatic Nuisance Preven-						
24	tion and Control Act of 1990 (16 U.S.C.						
25	4171(b)(4)(A);						

1	"(B) \$5,000,000 for competitive grants for					
2	university research on oyster diseases, oyster					
3	restoration, and oyster-related human health					
4	risks;					
5	"(C) \$5,000,000 for competitive grants for					
6	university research on the biology, prevention					
7	and forecasting of harmful algal blooms, includ-					
8	ing Pfiesteria piscicida; and					
9	"(D) \$3,000,000 for competitive grants for					
10	research contributing to the fisheries extension					
11	program to enhance, not supplant, existing core					
12	program funding.					
13	"(b) Limitations.—					
14	"(1) Administration.—There may not be					
15	used for administration of programs under this title					
16	in a fiscal year more than 5 percent of the lesser					
17	of—					
18	"(A) the amount authorized to be appro-					
19	priated under this title for the fiscal year; or					
20	"(B) the amount appropriated under this					
21	title for the fiscal year.					
22	"(2) Use for other offices or pro-					
23	GRAMS.—Sums appropriated under the authority of					
24	subsection (a)(2) shall not be available for adminis-					
25	tration of this title by the National Sea Grant Of-					

- 1 fice, for any other Administration or department
- 2 program, or for any other administrative expenses.".
- 3 (b) DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS.—Such section is fur-
- 4 ther amended by striking subsection (c) and inserting the
- 5 following:
- 6 "(c) Distribution of Funds.—In any fiscal year
- 7 in which the appropriations made pursuant to subsection
- 8 (a)(1) exceed the amounts appropriated for fiscal year
- 9 2003 for the purposes described in such subsection, the
- 10 Secretary shall distribute the excess amounts (except
- 11 amounts used for the administration of programs) solely
- 12 to—
- "(1) State sea grant programs on a merit re-
- viewed, competitive basis to support, enhance, and
- reward programs that are best managed and carry
- out the highest quality research, education, exten-
- sion, and training programs; and
- 18 "(2) national strategic initiatives.".
