- 3 SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON THE USE OF FUNDS.
- 4 No funds appropriated to the Department of Justice
- 5 or any other agency may be used to file any brief or to
- 6 otherwise advocate before any judicial or administrative
- 7 body any position with respect to the meaning of the Sec-
- 8 ond Amendment to the Constitution that is inconsistent

- 1 with existing Supreme Court precedent, as expressed in
- 2 United States v. Miller (307 U.S. 174 (1939)).
