## A BILL

To prohibit the use of taxpayer funds to advocate a position that is inconsistent with existing Supreme Court precedent with respect to the Second Amendment.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON THE USE OF FUNDS.**

4       No funds appropriated to the Department of Justice  
5       or any other agency may be used to file any brief or to  
6       otherwise advocate before any judicial or administrative  
7       body any position with respect to the meaning of the Sec-  
8       ond Amendment to the Constitution that is inconsistent

- 1 with existing Supreme Court precedent, as expressed in
- 2 United States v. Miller (307 U.S. 174 (1939)).
