A BILL

To amend the Civil Rights Act of 1964 to protect breastfeeding by new mothers.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Pregnancy Discrimina-
5 tion Act Amendments of 2001”.

6 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS TO TITLE VII OF THE CIVIL RIGHTS**

7 **ACT OF 1964.**

8 Section 701(k) of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 (42
9 U.S.C. 2000e(k)) is amended—

- 1 (1) by inserting “breastfeeding,” after “child-
2 birth,” each place it appears; and
3 (2) by adding at the end the following: “In this
4 subsection, the term ‘breastfeeding’ means the feed-
5 ing of a child directly from the breast or the expres-
6 sion of milk from the breast by a lactating woman.”.
