 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "National Beach Recre-
 - 5 ation Act".
 - 6 SEC. 2. TREATMENT OF RECREATION BENEFITS.
 - 7 Subsection (e)(2)(B) of the first section of the Act
 - 8 entitled "An Act authorizing Federal participation in the

2	approved August 13, 1946 (33 U.S.C. 426e(e)(2)(B)), is
3	amended by adding at the end the following:
4	"(iii) Procedures for treatment
5	OF CERTAIN BENEFITS.—In making rec-

7	retary shall develop and implement proce-
8	dures that treat recreation, hurricane and
9	storm damage reduction, and environ-
10	mental protection and restoration benefits
11	equally.".
