6	(a) Debt Reduction.—Section 806 of the Foreign
7	Assistance Act of 1961 (22 U.S.C. 2431d) is amended—
8	(1) in the section heading, by striking
9	"CONCESSIONAL LOANS" and inserting "LOANS
10	OR CREDITS"; and
11	(2) in subsection $(a)(1)$, by striking
12	"concessional loans" and inserting "loans (including
13	concessional loans) or credits".
14	(b) Debt-for-Nature Swaps.—Section 808(a)(1)
15	of the Foreign Assistance Act of 1961 (22 U.S.C.
16	2431f(a)(1)) is amended by striking "concessional loans"
17	and inserting "loans (including concessional loans) or
18	credits".
19	(c) Debt Buybacks.—Section 808(a)(2) of the For-
20	eign Assistance Act of 1961 (22 U.S.C. 2431f(a)(2)) is
21	amended by striking "concessional loans" and inserting
22	"loans (including concessional loans) or credits".
23	(d) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
24	this section shall apply to loans made or credits extended
25	before, on, or after the date of enactment of this Act.
