A BILL

To revise the boundary of the Wind Cave National Park in the State of South Dakota.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Wind Cave National
- 5 Park Boundary Revision Act of 2002".
- 6 SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.
- 7 In this Act:

1	(1) MAP.—The term "map" means the map en-				
2	titled "Wind Cave National Park Boundary Revi-				
3	sion", numbered 108/80,030, and dated June 2002				
4	(2) Park.—The term "Park" means the Win				
5	Cave National Park in the State.				
6	(3) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" mean				
7	the Secretary of the Interior.				
8	(4) STATE.—The term "State" means the State				
9	of South Dakota.				
10	SEC. 3. LAND ACQUISITION.				
11	(a) Authority.—				
12	(1) In general.—The Secretary may acquire				
13	the land or interest in land described in subsection				
14	(b)(1) for addition to the Park.				
15	(2) Means.—An acquisition of land under				
16	paragraph (1) may be made by donation, purchase				
17	from a willing seller with donated or appropriated				
18	funds, or exchange.				
19	(b) Boundary.—				
20	(1) MAP AND ACREAGE.—The land referred to				
21	in subsection (a)(1) shall consist of approximate				
22	5,675 acres, as generally depicted on the map.				
23	(2) AVAILABILITY OF MAP.—The map shall be				
24	on file and available for public inspection in the ap-				
25	propriate offices of the National Park Service.				

1 (3) REVISION.—The boundary of the Park shall 2 be adjusted to reflect the acquisition of land under 3 subsection (a)(1). SEC. 4. ADMINISTRATION. 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall administer any land acquired under section 3(a)(1) as part of the Park in accordance with laws (including regulations) ap-8 plicable to the Park. 9 (b) TRANSFER OFADMINISTRATIVE JURISDIC-10 TION.— 11 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall transfer 12 from the Director of the Bureau of Land Manage-13 ment to the Director of the National Park Service 14 administrative jurisdiction over the land described in 15 paragraph (2). 16 (2) Map and acreage.—The land referred to 17 in paragraph (1) consists of the approximately 80 18 acres of land identified on the map as "Bureau of 19 Land Management land". 20 SEC. 5. GRAZING. 21 (a) Grazing Permitted.—Subject to any permits 22 or leases in existence as of the date of acquisition, the 23 Secretary may permit the continuation of livestock grazing

on land acquired under section 3(a)(1).

- 1 (b) Limitation.—Grazing under subsection (a) shall
- 2 be at not more than the level existing on the date on which
- 3 the land is acquired under section 3(a)(1).
- 4 (c) Purchase of Permit or Lease.—The Sec-
- 5 retary may purchase the outstanding portion of a grazing
- 6 permit or lease on any land acquired under section
- $7 \ 3(a)(1).$
- 8 (d) Termination of Leases or Permits.—The
- 9 Secretary may accept the voluntary termination of a per-
- 10 mit or lease for grazing on any acquired land.

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
