A BILL

To expand the eligibility for membership in veterans
organizations.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MODIFICATION OF MEMBERSHIP REQUIRE-**
4 **MENT FOR EXEMPTION FROM TAX FOR VET-**
5 **ERANS' ORGANIZATIONS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subparagraph (B) of section
7 501(c)(19) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (relating
8 to list of exempt organizations) is amended by striking “or
9 widowers” and inserting “, widowers, or ancestors or lineal
10 descendants”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
2 this section shall apply to taxable years beginning after
3 the date of the enactment of this Act.
