1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 3 SECTION 1. CLAIMS RELATING TO HORN ISLAND, MIS-4 SISSIPPI. 5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, with respect to a civil action on a claim arising from the taking 6 by the United States of certain parcels of land on Horn 8 Island, Mississippi, that is brought in the 3-year period beginning on the date of enactment of this Act— 10 (1) the United States waives the right to raise 11 the affirmative defenses of res judicata and collat-
