- 3 SECTION 1. RENEWAL COMMUNITY BUSINESSES MAY

- 5 TAIN OTHER RENEWAL COMMUNITIES.
- 6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1400G of the Internal
- 7 Revenue Code of 1986 (defining renewal community busi-
- 8 nesses) is amended by inserting "and if section

- 1 1397C(b)(6) or 1397C(c)(5), as the case may be, was ap-
- 2 plied by substituting 'a renewal community, an adjacent
- 3 renewal community, or the next closest renewal commu-
- 4 nity' for 'a renewal community'" after "such section".
- 5 (b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
- 6 this section shall take effect on the date of the enactment
