## AN ACT

To reinstate and extend the deadline for commencement of construction of a hydroelectric project in the State of Illinois.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
2       tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TIME FOR FEDERAL ENERGY**2 **REGULATORY COMMISSION PROJECT.**

3 Notwithstanding the time period specified in section  
4 13 of the Federal Power Act (16 U.S.C. 806) that would  
5 otherwise apply to the Federal Energy Regulatory Com-  
6 mission project numbered 11214, the Commission may, at  
7 the request of the licensee for the project, and after rea-  
8 sonable notice, in accordance with the good faith, due dili-  
9 gence, and public interest requirements of that section and  
10 the Commission's procedures under that section—

11 (1) reinstate the license for the construction of  
12 the project as of the effective date of the surrender  
13 of the license; and

14 (2) extend the time period during which the li-  
15 censee is required to commence the construction of  
16 the project for 3 consecutive 2-year periods beyond  
17 the date that is 4 years after the date of issuance  
18 of the license.
