## A BILL

For the relief of Jaya Gulab Tolani and Hitesh Gulab Tolani.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.**

4       Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-  
5       poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.  
6       1101 et seq.), Jaya Gulab Tolani and Hitesh Gulab Tolani  
7       shall be held and considered to have been lawfully admit-  
8       ted to the United States for permanent residence as of  
9       the date of enactment of this Act upon payment of the  
10      required visa fees.

1 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.**

2       Upon the granting of permanent residence to Jaya  
3 Gulab Tolani and Hitesh Gulab Tolani, as provided in sec-  
4 tion 1, the Secretary of State shall instruct the proper offi-  
5 cer to reduce by the appropriate number during the cur-  
6 rent fiscal year the total number of immigrant visas avail-  
7 able to natives of the country of the aliens' birth under  
8 section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8  
9 U.S.C. 1153(a)).
