## A BILL

For the relief of Jaya Gulab Tolani and Hitesh Gulab Tolani.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.
- 4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-
- 5 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
- 6 1101 et seq.), Jaya Gulab Tolani and Hitesh Gulab Tolani
- 7 shall be held and considered to have been lawfully admit-
- 8 ted to the United States for permanent residence as of
- 9 the date of enactment of this Act upon payment of the
- 10 required visa fees.

## 1 SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.

- 2 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Jaya
- 3 Gulab Tolani and Hitesh Gulab Tolani, as provided in sec-
- 4 tion 1, the Secretary of State shall instruct the proper offi-
- 5 cer to reduce by the appropriate number during the cur-
- 6 rent fiscal year the total number of immigrant visas avail-
- 7 able to natives of the country of the aliens' birth under
- 8 section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8
- 9 U.S.C. 1153(a)).
