Mr. TORRICELLI introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions

## A BILL

- To amend the Public Health Service Act to provide for the development and operation of centers to conduct research with respect to infertility prevention, and for other purposes.
  - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
  - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
  - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
  - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Infertility Research
  - 5 Centers Act of 2002".

1	SEC. 2. GRANTS AND CONTRACTS FOR RESEARCH CENTERS							
2	WITH RESPECT TO INFERTILITY PREVEN-							
3	TION.							
4	Subpart 7 of part C of title IV of the Public Health							
5	Service Act (42 U.S.C. 285g et seq.) is amended by adding							
6	at the end the following new section:							
7	"SEC. 452H. RESEARCH CENTERS WITH RESPECT TO INFER-							
8	TILITY PREVENTION.							
9	"(a) In General.—The Director of the Institute,							
10	after consultation with the advisory council for the Insti-							
11	tute, shall make grants to, or enter into contracts with,							
12	public or nonprofit private entities for the development							
13	and operation of centers to conduct activities for the pur-							
14	pose of improving methods of preventing infertility.							
15	"(b) Number of Centers.—In carrying out sub-							
16	section (a), the Director of the Institute shall, subject to							
17	the extent of amounts made available in appropriations							
18	Acts, provide for the establishment of two centers with re-							
19	spect to infertility prevention.							
20	"(c) Use of Funds.—							
21	"(1) IN GENERAL.—Each center assisted under							
22	this section shall, in carrying out the purpose of the							
23	center involved—							
24	"(A) conduct clinical and other applied re-							
25	search, including clinical trials of new or im-							

1	proved drugs and devices for the diagnosis and
2	treatment of infertility in males and females;
3	"(B) develop protocols for training physi-
4	cians, scientists, nurses, and other health and
5	allied health professionals;
6	"(C) conduct training programs for such
7	individuals;
8	"(D) develop model continuing education
9	programs for such professionals; and
10	"(E) disseminate information to such pro-
11	fessionals and the public.
12	"(2) Stipends.—A center may use funds pro-
13	vided under subsection (a) to provide stipends for
14	health and allied health professionals enrolled in pro-
15	grams described in subparagraph (C) of paragraph
16	(1), and to provide fees to individuals serving as
17	subjects in clinical trials conducted under such para-
18	graph.
19	"(d) Coordination.—The Director of the Institute
20	shall, as appropriate, provide for the coordination of infor-
21	mation among the centers assisted under this section.
22	"(e) Facilities.—Each center assisted under sub-
23	section (a) shall use the facilities of a single institution,
24	or be formed from a consortium of cooperating institu-

- 1 tions, meeting such requirements as may be prescribed by
- 2 the Director of the Institute.
- 3 "(f) Period of Support.—Support of a center
- 4 under subsection (a) may be for a period not exceeding
- 5 5 years. Such period may be extended for one or more
- 6 additional periods not exceeding 5 years if the operations
- 7 of such center have been reviewed by an appropriate tech-
- 8 nical and scientific peer review group established by the
- 9 Director and if such group has recommended to the Direc-
- 10 tor that such period should be extended.
- 11 "(g) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—For the
- 12 purpose of carrying out this section, there are authorized
- 13 to be appropriated \$30,000,000 for fiscal year 2003, and
- 14 such sums as may be necessary for each of the fiscal years
- 15 2004 and 2005.".
- 16 SEC. 3. LOAN REPAYMENT PROGRAM FOR RESEARCH WITH
- 17 RESPECT TO INFERTILITY PREVENTION.
- Part F of title IV of the Public Health Service Act
- 19 (42 U.S.C. 287d et seq.) is amended—
- 20 (1) by redesignating the second section 487F
- 21 (relating to the pediatric research loan repayment
- program) as section 487G; and
- 23 (2) by inserting after section 487G (as so re-
- designated) the following section:

- 4 "(a) Establishment.—The Secretary, in consulta-
- 5 tion with the Director of the National Institute of Child
- 6 Health and Human Development, shall establish a pro-
- 7 gram of entering into agreements with qualified health
- 8 professionals (including graduate students) under which
- 9 such health professionals agree to conduct research with
- 10 respect to infertility prevention, in consideration of the
- 11 Federal Government agreeing to repay, for each year of
- 12 such service, not more than \$20,000 of the principal and
- 13 interest of the educational loans of such health profes-
- 14 sionals.
- 15 "(b) Application of Provisions.—The provisions
- 16 of sections 338B, 338C, and 338E shall apply to the pro-
- 17 gram established in subsection (a) to the same extent and
- 18 in the same manner as such provisions apply to the Na-
- 19 tional Health Service Corps Loan Repayment Program es-
- 20 tablished in subpart III of part D of title III.
- 21 "(c) Funding.—Amounts appropriated for carrying
- 22 out this section shall remain available until the expiration
- 23 of the second fiscal year beginning after the fiscal year
- 24 for which the amounts were appropriated.".
