A BILL

To extend the deadline for commencement of construction of a hydroelectric project in the State of Oregon.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF TIME FOR FEDERAL ENERGY
- 4 REGULATORY COMMISSION PROJECT.
- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding the time period
- 6 specified in section 13 of the Federal Power Act (16
- 7 U.S.C. 806) that would otherwise apply to the Federal En-

- 1 ergy Regulatory Commission project number 11509, the
- 2 Commission shall, at the request of the licensee for the
- 3 project, and after reasonable notice, extend the time pe-
- 4 riod during which the licensee is required to commence
- 5 the construction of the project for 3 consecutive 2-year
- 6 periods.
- 7 (b) Effective Date.—Subsection (a) takes effect
- 8 on the date of the expiration of the extension issued by
- 9 the Commission under section 13 of the Federal Power
- 10 Act (16 U.S.C. 806) for Federal Energy Regulatory Com-
- 11 mission project number 11509.
- 12 (c) Reinstatement of Expired License.—If the
- 13 period required for commencement of construction of the
- 14 project described in subsection (a) has expired prior to the
- 15 date of the enactment of this Act, the Commission shall
- 16 reinstate the license effective as of the date of its expira-
- 17 tion and the first extension authorized under subsection
- 18 (a) shall take effect on the date of such expiration.
