3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF FRANCIS DAYLE “CHICK”**

4 **HEARN POST OFFICE.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 5805 White Oak Avenue in

1 Encino, California, shall be known and designated as the
2 “Francis Dayle ‘Chick’ Hearn Post Office”.

3 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
4 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
6 be deemed to be a reference to the Francis Dayle “Chick”
7 Hearn Post Office.
