A BILL

To amend the Higher Education Act of 1965 to provide for an increase in the amount of student loans that are eligible for forgiveness in exchange for the service of the individual as a teacher.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Quality Teacher Re-
5 cruitment Act of 2001”.

6 **SEC. 2. GUARANTEED LOANS.**

7 Section 428J of the Higher Education Act of 1965
8 (20 U.S.C. 1078–10) is amended—

1 (1) in subsection (b)(1), by striking subparagraph
2 graph (A) and inserting the following:

3 “(A) in an elementary school or secondary
4 school;”;

5 (2) in subsection (c)(1), by striking “\$5,000”
6 and inserting “\$17,750”; and

7 (3) by striking subsection (f).

8 SEC. 3. DIRECT LOANS.

9 Section 460 of the Higher Education Act of 1965 (20
10 U.S.C. 1087j) is amended—

11 (1) in subsection (b)(1)(A), by striking clause
12 (i) and inserting the following:

15 (2) in subsection (c)(1), by striking “\$5,000”
16 and inserting “\$17,750”; and

17 (3) by striking subsection (f).
