A BILL

For the relief of Jesus Raul Apodaca-Madrid and certain of his family members.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.
- 4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-
- 5 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.
- 6 1101 et seq.), Jesus Raul Apodaca-Madrid and the per-
- 7 sons named in section 3, who are members of his family,
- 8 shall be held and considered to have been lawfully admit-
- 9 ted to the United States for permanent residence as of

- 1 the date of enactment of this Act upon payment of the
- 2 required visa fees.

3 SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.

- 4 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Jesus
- 5 Raul Apodaca-Madrid and the persons named in section
- 6 3, as provided in section 1, the Secretary of State shall
- 7 instruct the proper officer to reduce by the appropriate
- 8 number during the current fiscal year the total number
- 9 of immigrant visas available to natives of the country of
- 10 the aliens' birth under section 203(a) of the Immigration
- 11 and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)).

12 SEC. 3. ADDITIONAL BENEFICIARIES FOR RELIEF.
