Mr. Enzi introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Veterans' Affairs

A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to establish a national cemetery for veterans in the Cheyenne, Wyoming, metropolitan area.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. ESTABLISHMENT OF NATIONAL CEMETERY IN
- 4 CHEYENNE, WYOMING, METROPOLITAN
- 5 AREA.
- 6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Veterans Affairs
- 7 shall establish, in accordance with chapter 24 of title 38,
- 8 United States Code, a national cemetery in the Cheyenne,
- 9 Wyoming, metropolitan area to serve the needs of veterans
- 10 and their families.

- 1 (b) Consultation in Selection of Site.—Before
- 2 selecting the site for the national cemetery established
- 3 under subsection (a), the Secretary shall consult with—
- 4 (1) appropriate officials of the State of Wyo-
- 5 ming and local officials of the Cheyenne metropoli-
- 6 tan area; and
- 7 (2) appropriate officials of the United States,
- 8 including the Administrator of General Services,
- 9 with respect to land belonging to the United States
- in that area that would be suitable to establish the
- 11 national cemetery under subsection (a).
- 12 (c) Authority To Accept Donation of Parcel
- 13 OF LAND.—(1) The Secretary may accept on behalf of the
- 14 United States the gift of an appropriate parcel of real
- 15 property. The Secretary shall have administrative jurisdic-
- 16 tion over such parcel of real property, and shall use such
- 17 parcel to establish the national cemetery under subsection
- 18 (a).
- 19 (2) For purposes of Federal income, estate, and gift
- 20 taxes, the real property accepted under paragraph (1)
- 21 shall be considered as a gift to the United States.
- 22 (d) Report.—As soon as practicable after the date
- 23 of enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall submit to
- 24 Congress a report on the establishment of the national
- 25 cemetery under subsection (a). The report shall set forth

- 1 a schedule for the establishment of the national cemetery
- 2 and an estimate of costs associated with the establishment

3 of the national cemetery.
