A BILL

To increase scholarship assistance under the Police Corps program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 SECTION 1. POLICE CORPS.

4 Subtitle A of title XX of the Violent Crime Control
5 and Law Enforcement Act of 1994, the Police Corps Act
6 (42 U.S.C. 14091 et seq.), is amended—

7 (1) in section 200106—

8 (A) in subsection (a)(2)—

9 (i) in subparagraph (A), by striking

10 “\$7,500” and inserting “\$10,000”;

1 (ii) in subparagraph (B), by striking
2 “\$10,000” and inserting “\$13,333”; and

3 (iii) in subparagraph (C), by striking
4 “\$30,000” and inserting “\$40,000”; and
5 (B) in subsection (b)(2)—

6 (i) in subparagraph (A), by striking
7 “\$7,500” and inserting “\$10,000”;

8 (ii) in subparagraph (B), by striking
9 “\$10,000” and inserting “\$13,333”; and

10 (iii) in subparagraph (C), by striking
11 “\$30,000” and inserting “\$40,000”;

12 (2) in section 200108, by striking “\$250” and
13 inserting “\$400”;

14 (3) in section 20110(2), by striking “no more
15 than 10 percent” and inserting “except with permis-
16 sion of the Director, no more than 25 percent”;

17 (4) by striking section 200111; and

18 (5) in section 200112, by striking “fiscal year
19 2002” and inserting “each of fiscal years 2002
20 through 2005”.
