## A BILL

For the relief of Daniel King Cairo

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENCE.**

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, for pur-  
5 poses of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C.  
6 1101 et seq.), Daniel King Cairo shall be held and consid-  
7 ered to have been lawfully admitted to the United States  
8 for permanent residence as of the date of enactment of  
9 this Act upon payment of the required visa fees.

10 **SEC. 2. REDUCTION OF NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.**

11 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Daniel  
12 King Cairo, the Secretary of State shall instruct the prop-

1 er officer to reduce by the appropriate number during the  
2 current fiscal year the total number of immigrant visas  
3 available to natives of the country of the alien's birth  
4 under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality  
5 Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)).
