A BILL

To provide for the conduct of a study concerning health services research.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. REPORT ON HEALTH SERVICES RESEARCH.
- 4 (a) Contract.—The Director of the Agency for
- 5 Healthcare Research and Quality shall enter into a con-
- 6 tract with the Institute of Medicine of the National Acad-
- 7 emy of Sciences for the conduct of a study on the ade-
- 8 quacy of the organization and financing in the field of
- 9 health services research for meeting the future informa-
- 10 tion needs of the United States.

- 1 (b) Areas of Review.—In conducting the study
- 2 under subsection (a), the Institute of Medicine shall at a
- 3 minimum consider the Federal role in supporting health
- 4 services research, and in particular, the role of the Agency
- 5 for Healthcare Research and Quality in leading the Fed-
- 6 eral effort and coordinating the complementary roles of
- 7 other Federal agencies, as well as the private foundations
- 8 and corporations, that conduct and fund health services
- 9 research.
- 10 (c) Report.—Not later than ____ year after the
- 11 date on which the contract is entered into under sub-
- 12 section (a), the Institute of Medicine shall complete the
- 13 study under such subsection and submit a report to the
- 14 Director of the Agency for Healthcare Research and Qual-
- 15 ity and the appropriate committees of Congress that con-
- 16 tains the results of such study.
