Mr. BUNNING introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred
to the Committee on Armed Services

A BILL

To authorize the conveyance of a portion of the Bluegrass
Army Depot, Kentucky, to preserve a historic Civil War
battlefield.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LAND CONVEYANCE, BLUEGRASS ARMY DEPOT,**
4 **KENTUCKY.**

5 (a) LAND CONVEYANCE AUTHORIZED.—The Sec-
6 retary of the Army may convey, without consideration, to
7 Madison County, Kentucky (in this section referred to as
8 the “County”), all right, title, and interest of the United
9 States in and to a parcel of real property, including any
10 improvements thereon, consisting of approximately 3 acres

1 at the Bluegrass Army Depot, Richmond, Kentucky, and
2 including the building known as Quarters 29.

3 (b) CONDITION OF CONVEYANCE.—The Secretary
4 may not make the conveyance of property authorized by
5 subsection (a) unless the County agrees to utilize the prop-
6 erty for historical preservation and education purposes.

7 (c) REVERSIONARY INTEREST.—If the Secretary de-
8 termines at any time that the property conveyed under
9 subsection (a) has ceased to be utilized for the purposes
10 specified in subsection (b), all right, title, and interest in
11 and to the property shall revert to the United States, and
12 the United States shall have the right of immediate entry
13 onto the property. Any determination under this sub-
14 section shall be made on the record after an opportunity
15 for a hearing.

16 (d) ADMINISTRATIVE EXPENSES.—The Secretary
17 shall apply section 2695 of title 10, United States Code,
18 to the conveyance authorized by subsection (a).

19 (e) DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY.—The exact acreage
20 and legal description of the real property to be conveyed
21 under subsection (a) shall be determined by a survey satis-
22 factory to the Secretary. The cost of the survey shall be
23 borne by the County.

24 (f) ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—The Sec-
25 retary may require such additional terms and conditions

1 in connection with the conveyance under subsection (a) as
2 the Secretary considers appropriate to protect the inter-
3 ests of the United States.

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
