## A BILL

To compensate agricultural producers in the State of New Mexico that suffered crop losses as a result of use of a herbicide by the Bureau of Land Management.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. COMPENSATION OF NEW MEXICO PRODUCERS
- 4 FOR CROP DAMAGE FROM BLM USE OF HER-
- 5 BICIDE.
- 6 (a) In General.—The Secretary of Agriculture, in
- 7 consultation with the Secretary of the Interior, may use
- 8 such funds of the Commodity Credit Corporation as are
- 9 necessary to compensate agricultural producers in the

1	State of New Mexico that suffered crop losses as a result
2	of the use of the herbicide tebuthiuron by the Bureau of
3	Land Management during the 2002 calendar year.
4	(b) Liability.—Nothing in this section constitutes
5	an admission of liability by the United States arising from
6	the use of the herbicide tebuthiuron by the Bureau of
7	Land Management.
8	(c) Regulations.—
9	(1) In General.—The Secretary of Agriculture
10	may promulgate such regulations as are necessary to
11	implement this section.
12	(2) PROCEDURE.—The promulgation of the reg-
13	ulations and administration of this section shall be
14	made without regard to—
15	(A) the notice and comment provisions of
16	section 553 of title 5, United States Code;
17	(B) the Statement of Policy of the Sec-
18	retary of Agriculture effective July 24, 1971
19	(36 Fed. Reg. 13804), relating to notices of
20	proposed rulemaking and public participation in
21	rulemaking; and
22	(C) chapter 35 of title 44, United States
23	Code (commonly known as the "Paperwork Re-
24	duction Act").

1 (3) Congressional review of agency rule-2 Making.—In carrying out this subsection, the Sec-3 retary shall use the authority provided under section 4 808 of title 5, United States Code.
