Mr. BURNS introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Health, Education, Labor, and Pensions

A BILL

To extend the cooling off period in the labor dispute between the Pacific Maritime Association and the International Longshore and Warehouse Union.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENSION OF COOLING OFF PERIOD.**

4 With respect to the labor dispute between the Pacific
5 Maritime Association and the International Longshore
6 and Warehouse Union, the cooling off period provided for
7 in the order of the district court in the case of United
8 States of America v. Pacific Maritime Association, and
9 International Longshore and Warehouse Union pursuant
10 to the petition of the Attorney General (as provided for

1 in section 208 of the Labor Management Relations Act,
2 1947 (29 U.S.C. 178)) shall be extended for an additional
3 30 days.
